### **Programme 1: First Dance on Second Avenue**

Touring their fourth album 'First Dance on Second Avenue', She'Koyokh goes on a formidably gymnastic journey across Eastern Europe and beyond. The group starts out in 1950s New York and finishes up in a Turkish sauna, via Romanian mountains and Serbian villages, featuring klezmer, virtuosic Balkan dances and soulful songs from Albania, Armenia and Bulgaria.

### **Programme 2: Klezmer Special (4-7 musicians)**

A captivating programme of klezmer music and Ladino songs, reviving the instrumental Jewish music of Yiddish speaking communities in Eastern Europe, as well as the songs of Ladino speaking Jews who were expelled from Spain in 1492 and migrated to the Ottoman Empire.

### **Programme 3: Balkan Voices**

*with special guests Angelina Kasabova, vocals (Bulgaria) & Monooka, vocals/puppetry (Romania)*

Lead vocalist Çigdem Aslan is joined by special guest singers from Romania and Bulgaria to present an epic, all-embracing journey through Eastern Europe, the Balkans and beyond, displaying their expertise and virtuosic skills in a wealth of regional and national styles.

### **Programme 4: Winter Songs from the Baltics to the Black Sea**

*with special guest Monooka, vocals/puppetry (Romania)*

A winter voyage from the Baltics to the Black Sea, through mesmerising seasonal songs, traditional tunes and a good dose of foot-stomping, festive klezmer music. Lead vocalist Çigdem Aslan shares the stage with Romanian singer and puppeteer, Monooka, for an alternative Christmas concert.
