CELEBRATING TEN YEARS OF OUTSTANDING CHAMBER MUSIC IN BELGRAVIA

Eaton Square Concerts launches autumn 2016 season

Eaton Square Concerts announces its autumn 2016 season. During the season and into spring 2017 the concert series celebrates 10 years of presenting chamber music concerts from internationally renowned musicians.

Highlights of the season include Katherine Bryan performing with pianist Tim Carey in a concert of music from her latest album *The Silver Bow*. The disc was chosen as one of Classic FM's top 20 albums of 2015 and features iconic pieces for solo violin specially arranged by Katherine. Comprising celebrated musicians Thomas Gould (violin), Benjamin Roskams (viola) and Ashok Klouda (cello) the Artea Trio performs J.S. Bach's monumental Goldberg Variations, originally written for keyboard.

Eaton Square Concerts is a keen supporter of young musicians at the start of their careers. Since 2008 it has awarded the St Peter's Prize – in conjunction with the Royal Academy of Music – to the string quartet at the Academy which shows particular promise. Previous winners of this prize include the Piatti (2011/12) and Badke (2008/09) Quartets. To celebrate this continued partnership with the RAM the Piatti Quartet will return to Eaton Square Concerts on 13th October to perform with current prizewinners the Fitzroy Quartet.

Other concerts in the autumn 2016 season include a programme of Bach and Handel from the Vasari Singers; and a recital by renowned Portuguese pianist Artur Pizarro, winner of the 1990 Leeds International Piano Competition.

Musical excellence has long been associated with St Peter's Eaton Square, which has been the home of Eaton Square Concerts since November 2006. Past concerts have included Trevor Pinnock, Raphael Wallfisch, Stile Antico and Peter Donohoe as well as singers Carolyn Sampson and Sir John Tomlinson. Eaton Square Concerts has been a proud part of the Belgravia community since the series' inception, and is pleased to draw in audience members from further afield to enjoy concerts in this historic setting.

Tickets for the autumn 2016 season are now on sale, and include a complimentary glass of wine courtesy of Jeroboams.
