He is Director of Music at **Clare College, Cambridge**, co-founder and Principal Conductor of The Dmitri Ensemble, and guest conducts around the world. He studied music at Clare College and conducting at the Royal College of Music.

Ross is a **renowned conductor of oratorio repertoire**, and is passionate about newly-written and unjustly-neglected works. He is a composer in his own right and records exclusively for **Harmonia Mundi**.
