Jonathan Dove's *In Damascus* for tenor and string quartet is a special commission for the **Sacconi Quartet** and tenor **Mark Padmore**, set to the words of Syrian poet **Ali Safar'**s 'A Black Cloud in a Leaden White Sky', which sensitively recount the stories of everyday life in a war-torn city. Safar's text is a poignant reflection of the plight of those caught up in the Syrian conflict, stemming from the clashes between the Syrian - Turkish border.

The work received its world premiere at the Sacconi Chamber Music Festival in May 2016, and was released on disc with Signum Records in June 2017.

The award-winning **Sacconi Quartet** is one of the UK's leading string quartets, known throughout the world for its creativity, energy and integrity of interpretation.

The quartet has enjoyed a highly successful international career, performing regularly throughout Europe, at London's major venues, in recordings and on TV & radio broadcasts.
