An evening of live music and readings with the renowned Sacconi Quartet, critically acclaimed pianist Melvyn Tan, award-winning actor Harriet Walter. 'Late Thoughts' presents works never heard in performance by the composers or seen in print by the writers before they died.

Through the moving final works of Beethoven and Benjamin Britten, and the words of writers including Thomas Mann, Virginia Woolf, WB Yeats and Samuel Beckett, this unique concert reflects on the creative mind near the end of its life.

Unearthly, poignant, and captivating music will be paired with a selection of readings in a performance which reveals that, even in their twilight years, the urge to create never dwindled for these writers and composers.

Their programme will feature an incredibly wide range of composers including 17th– century Purcell, the celestial soundscapes of Jamaicanborn British composer Alberga's Quartet No.2 and Beethoven's Quartet No.16.
